7.1.5 Policy document on Restricted entry of Automobiles into the campus.

- All students and staff members are responsible for parking their vehicle in the allotted area.
- Automobiles must stop or slow down near the main gate to recognize their identity before entering the college campus for checking by the security personal.
- Parking markers have been installed in prominent locations across Dr TTIT campus to
 preserve its beauty. As a result, signage boards indicating permitted to park and
 prohibited from parking.
- For a two-wheeler, it is mandatory to wear helmet.
- The speed limit should not cross 10Kmph inside the college campus.
- To avoid accidents or endangering the safety of others, vehicle operators must keep their vehicles under control at all times.
- Students should not create sound pollution by their vehicle inside the campus at any point of time.
- The events like bike race, vehicle race, elephant procession is prohibited in college campus and hostel ground.
- Vehicles are not permitted to move on grass and lawns.
- Driving in the campus with the influence of drugs or alcohol is highly prohibited in the campus and will be reported to the authorities.
- Any accidents inside the college campus will be reported to the Principal, intrun
 investigation will be carried out. The necessary first aid will be given.

Rules and regulations for Pedestrian friendly pathway

The following are the rules and regulations to be followed to use pedestrian friendly pathway.

- · Littering is prohibited on pedestrian friendly pathway.
- All are required to make use most of the pedestrian-friendly route provided inside the campus.
- Increase awareness and visibility between motor vehicles and pedestrians to prevent pedestrian risks on the Dr. TTIT campus.

BAN OF PLASTIC IN DRTTIT CAMPUS

India is set to improve a national wide ban on single use plastic and the goal to make India free of single use plastics by 2022.
