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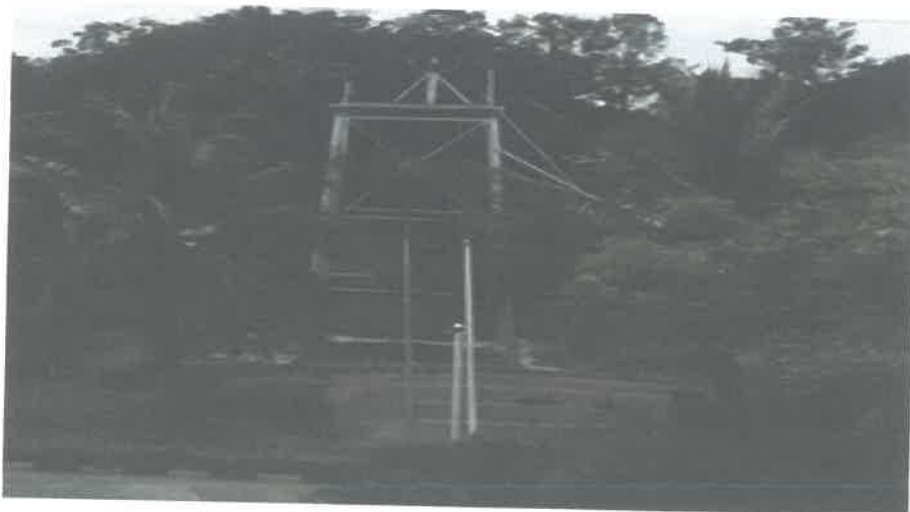

More than 100 members of the Dalit Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry are registered vendors of 10 Tata companies.

The value of business outsourced to vendors under TAAP has grown from about Rs400 million in 2010-11 to about Rs900 million in 2011-12. (Figures for 2012-13 are being computed.) Tata companies are engaged in generating indirect employment through training and in directly recruiting to create employment for scheduled caste and tribe youth under TAAP; direct employment is generated mainly in the services segment.

TCS conduct interviews of students post completion of training and recruit any students, if found suitable.
